OK – **we** are not going into space, but we'll be there behind-the-scenes with NASA on Thursday, January 29, for the scheduled launch of the first Earth-observing satellite to collect data on Earth's soil moisture. The mission, referred to as <u>SMAP</u>, will launch the "Soil Moisture Active Passive" Observatory into space for three years to track water movement that will help scientists to better understand our weather patterns.
